Dear Mr. Alqi Kushi,

We are pleased to inform you about the opening of the new Stipendium Hungaricum Call for Applications for studies starting in the academic year 2022-2023. Please find the Call for Applications attached. Please note that the Call is also available on our official website: www.stipendiumhungaricum.hu

According to the schedule of the application process, the most important deadlines are the following:
15 January 2022 – application deadline to Stipendium Hungaricum
28 February 2022 - deadline of sending the nomination list to Tempus Public Foundation.

The opening of the DreamApply online application surface for SH applicants is expected in the middle of November; you will be notified about the exact time and date in the upcoming days.

By the end of January 2022 TPF will proceed with the technical check of the submitted applications and the list of eligible candidates will be sent to you. Sending Partners will be requested to send us the list of candidates nominated to the Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship no later than 28 February 2022. Please note that the deadline for the nomination is strict, we are unable to accept the nomination list after this date.

Please note that in order to be able to exploit the total number of scholarship quota our partners are required to add a list of reservee students to the nomination list - if it is possible based on the number of incoming applications. Please be informed that the total number of nominees has increased from 140 % to 200 % of the quota set in the MoU. In case the number of applications does not reach 200 % of the quota, the sending party have the option not to set up a candidate list. In this case all applicants are considered as nominees and all of them will take part in institutional evaluation.

Based on the mentioned timeframe, prospective applicants will have two months to collect all the required documents and submit their application. The main changes in this year's Call for Applications are the following:

- From 2022/2023 academic year in addition to the bachelor, master, one-tier-master and doctoral programmes applicants can apply for postgraduate specialist training courses. Postgraduate specialist training courses provide opportunity to obtain a specialized qualification after bachelor's or master's degree. Those applicants who apply for these programmes need to be on the nomination

lists sent by the sending partners, that means that applicants for these programmes are counted towards the quota.

- Those Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Holders can apply for the programme who apply to continue their studies at a higher level of education (e.g. bachelor Scholarship Holders can apply for master studies).
- Medical certificate is mandatory only for the applicants nominated by the Sending Partners and must be submitted until 15 April.
- From 2022/2023 academic year not all doctoral schools require Statement of accept issued by the Supervisor at the Host Institution. In case it is required by the doctoral programme it must be submitted until 15 March 2022.
- Applicants will be automatically rejected during the technical check if
 - they were awarded the Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship for the 2020/21 or for the 2021/22 academic year, but after accepting their scholarship, did not travel to Hungary and did not start their studies, nor did they notify Tempus Public Foundation of this fact until 31 August
 - they have postponed their scholarship awarded in the 2020/21 application round, but did not travel to Hungary and did not start their studies next year, nor did they notify Tempus Public Foundation of this fact until 31 August.
- The scholarship status is terminated if the Scholarship Holder does not fulfil their obligation to participate in medical screenings, and their additional obligations set out in the healthcare protocol, or he/she is deemed unfit during the obligatory medical examination.
- Related to the allocation of applicants, in order to support student diversity, the number of eligible applicants from the same country may be limited in case of certain study programmes due to the limited number of places offered in the Stipendium Hungaricum programme (e.g. medical programmes).

Please note, that you will also be able to consult the submitted documents of all candidates via the Dream Apply online application system. In order to enter, you are required to use the same login/password that you have received during the last selection period.

We would highly appreciate your kind assistance in promoting the Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship opportunity through your network. The website to download our foreign language brochures for this purpose will be sent to you shortly.
