- group work and tasks depending on your level of study in international teams

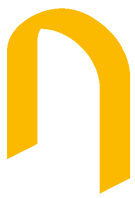


Accompanying Program (21/08/2023 – 24/08/2023)

Requirements

International applicants must submit both Curriculum Vitae (max. 2 pages) and letter of motivation (max. 1,800 characters), which show personal interest and qualifications regarding the topic and proof of English language skills (level B2 is desirable, no certificate necessary). You can submit your documents within the application process on our website.

Scholarship and Accommodation

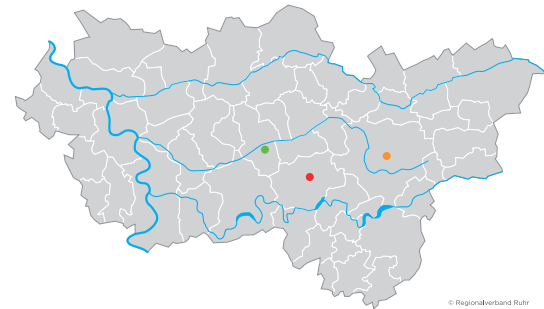
Scholarships would be awarded for your travel expenses, accommodation, catering and insurance. Please note that travel expenses will be refunded only up to a certain travel allowance. The height of this allowance depends on your country of origin. The application for the Summer School also counts as application for a scholarship. A separate application is not necessary.

Your accommodation would be a hostel close to Dortmund city center and you would be accommodated in four-bed rooms.

Event Location and Region

The Summer School will take place at the Dortmund University of Applied Sciences and Arts, North-Rhine Westphalia, Germany.

Dortmund is situated in the Ruhr Metropolis, the largest metropolitan area in Germany. Innovation and digital transformation are the driving forces behind the regional structural change from a former industrial location to a technology and science hotspot. The Ruhr Metropolis has a young, creative cultural scene and stands for a cordial life together.
