

Professor Michael Robinson Dr. Michael Robinson is a professor of mathematics at American University. His work touches on signal processing, dynamics, and applications of topology, including tracking, communication network analysis, acoustics and radio, data fusion, corpora for file formats, and analyses of large language models.



Professor Richard Ressler Dr. Richard Ressler is a Hurst Senior Professorial Lecturer in American University's Math and Statistics department. He joined the faculty in 2019 and serves as an Associate Director of the Data Science programs. Prior to joining academia, Richard served for over 40 years as a senior operations research analyst and leader in industry and the military.



Professor Artur Elezi Prior to joining AU in 2002, Dr Elezi held postdoctoral positions at Stanford University and Brigham Young University. His training is in applications of Algebraic Geometry in High Energy Physics, especially String Theory. His current research interests are in algebraic classical and quantum coding theory and in the intersection theory of the moduli spaces of curves.
